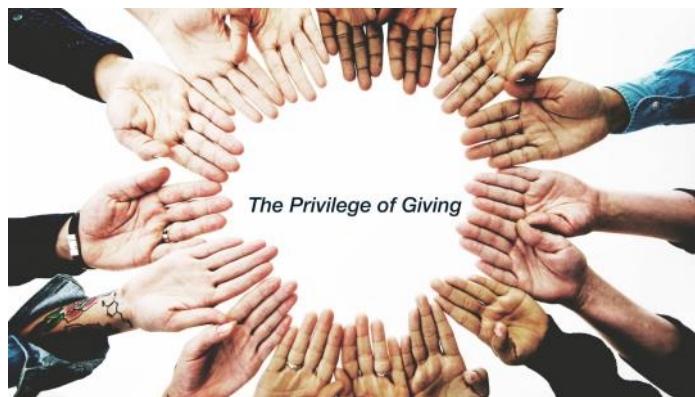

FAITH FORMATION

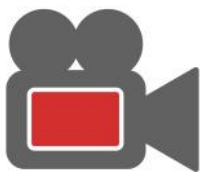
