### The Rite of Sending

On Sunday, February 19 we will celebrate the Rite of Sending with our three catechumens, **Amina Swann, Seda Swann, and Wyatt Hull.**

These catechumens indicated their desire to become members of the Catholic Church during the Rite of Acceptance. Since that time, they have been preparing through prayer and study with their sponsors and catechists. In the Rite of Sending, the readiness of the catechumens is recognized and the catechumens are "sent" by the parish to the Rite of Election to be celebrated with the bishop at Our Lady of Perpetual Help on February 25th. After that Rite, they will no longer be catechumens, but rather the "Elect". They will move forward to the final period of preparation and purification before they receive the sacraments of initiation (Baptism/Confirmation/Eucharist). Pray for Amina, Seda, and Wyatt as they continue the path to full communion with the Church at Easter Vigil.

I am very pleased to announce that we have a plan for celebrating Masses during our upcoming renovation. Once the diocese has granted final approval of our design, it is estimated that work will begin in August.

**Trinity Ecumenical Parish** has graciously offered their facilities to us. Although there are a number of details to work through, our plan is to have our Saturday 5:00 Mass, Sunday 4:00 Mass, and even Thursday Mass in Trinity's sanctuary. Youth Faith Formation will follow Sunday 4:00 Mass in classrooms at Trinity, so there will be little disruption in the current schedule. We will just be a couple of miles down the road! Pastor Philip and others at Trinity were very generous, and they are pleased to be able to help us.

Our current plan is to relocate staff offices to the lower-level classrooms at Resurrection. We are cautiously optimistic that we will have use of Morrow Hall for gatherings such as funeral receptions, potlucks, and Wednesday evening adult faith formation.

Resurrection and Trinity will use a single person to coordinate the various activities. Jennifer McLaughlin will be that person for Resurrection, and Debbie Tyler will be the person at Trinity. Many of you may be familiar with Debbie since she is a parishioner here at Resurrection. Jennifer should be contacted first, and then she will work with Debbie.
